

**Information on personal data processing  
for persons residing on the property  
located in Grodzisk Mazowiecki at 42 Traugutta Street**

<p><b>Who is the controller of personal data?</b></p>	<p>In accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter: GDPR), we inform you that for the purposes of the operation of the video surveillance system, a relevant agreement has been concluded on co-administration, according to which the controllers (co-Controllers) of your personal data are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Terra Recycling Spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością</b> based in Grodzisk Mazowiecki (05-825) at R. <p><b>For what purpose and on what legal basis do we process personal data?</b></p>	<p>Your personal data may be used by the Controllers for the following purposes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. monitoring of waste storage and disposal sites in accordance with the Waste Act of December 14, 2012 (legal basis: Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR - legal obligation),</li> <li>2. ensure the safety of employees and co-workers, protect property and keep confidential information, the disclosure of which could expose the Controllers to harm, as part of the video surveillance conducted (legal basis: Article 6(1)(f) GDPR - legitimate interest),</li> <li>3. ensuring the safety of persons residing on the premises of the Controllers' offices or plants, located at 42 Traugutta Street in Grodzisk Mazowiecki (legal basis: Article 6(1)(f) GDPR - legitimate interest),</li> <li>4. investigating or defending against possible claims related to being on the premises of the Controllers, or in connection with the need to prove certain facts that are of material importance to the Controllers in this regard (legal basis: Article 6(1)(f) GDPR - legitimate interest).</li> </ol> <p>Being on the premises of the Controllers' offices or plants, located at 42 Traugutta Street in Grodzisk Mazowiecki, entails to be covered by video surveillance, and thus the processing of your personal data by the Controllers.</p>
<p><b>Will the data be subject to profiling?</b></p>	<p>Your personal data will not be used to make decisions based solely on automated processing of personal data, including profiling within the meaning of Article 22 of the GDPR.</p>
<p><b>How long will we use the acquired data?</b></p>	<p>Personal data will be used for the period necessary for the purposes indicated above. Depending on the legal basis, this will be respectively:</p>

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. a period of 1 month from the date of recording (i.e. after a visit to the Controller's headquarters or facility),</li> <li>2. the period until the final conclusion of the proceedings, if your data will constitute evidence in a proceeding under the law or the Controller became aware that they may constitute evidence in the proceeding,</li> <li>3. period until any effective objection is filed.</li> </ol>
<p><b>What rights does the person whose data we process have?</b></p>	<p>You have the right to make a request regarding:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. access to data (including obtaining information on what data is processed by the Controllers and to what extent, as well as obtaining copies of the data) - details: article 15 of the GDPR,</li> <li>2. rectify data (i.e., correct it if the data processed by the Controllers is incorrect or incomplete) - details: article 16 of the GDPR,</li> <li>3. deletion of data (if, for example, the data are no longer needed for the purposes for which they were collected or the Controllers have no legal basis for processing the data) - details: article 17 of the GDPR,</li> <li>4. limitation of data processing (if, for example, you question the accuracy of the personal data used by the Controllers, if the data are no longer needed by the Controllers, but need to be processed because you are pursuing a claim) - details: article 18 of the GDPR,</li> <li>5. object to the processing of personal data, including profiling (if the personal data is processed on the basis of a legitimate interest of the Controllers, or is used for direct marketing purposes) - details: article 21 GDPR,</li> <li>6. transfer of data to another controller (if the processing of data provided to the Controllers is carried out by automated means, on the basis of consent or on the basis of a contract) - details: article 20 GDPR.</li> </ol> <p>In addition, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection (supervisory authority) if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the law (for more information: <a href="https://uodo.gov.pl/pl/83/155">https://uodo.gov.pl/pl/83/155</a>).</p> <p>As agreed by the Controllers, the requests are carried out by each Controller in accordance with the responsibilities.</p>
<p><b>To whom do we share data?</b></p>	<p>With all guarantees of data security, we may provide your data to other entities, including entities authorized to receive them under applicable laws (e.g., an authority authorized to control the activities of the in the field of waste management, courts, prosecutor's office, Police, ABW, National Fiscal Administration, Border Guard), entities processing them on our behalf (e.g., technical service providers, hosting service providers, analytics service providers, entities providing us with consulting services) and other Controllers (e.g., notary or law firms) including other Elemental Group companies.</p>
